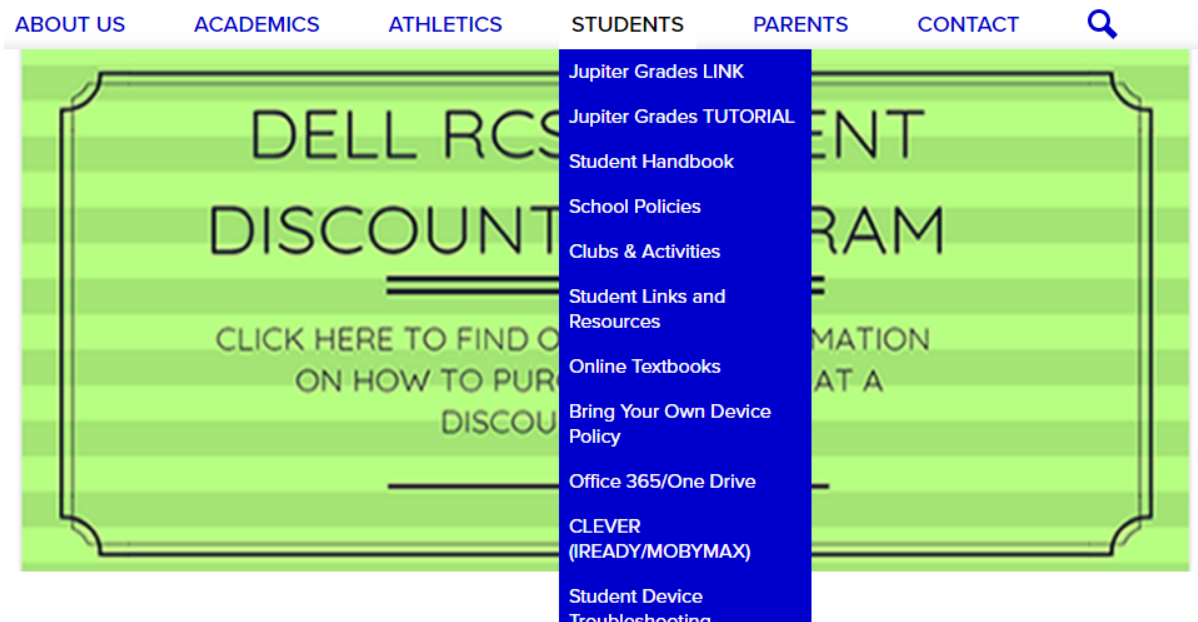
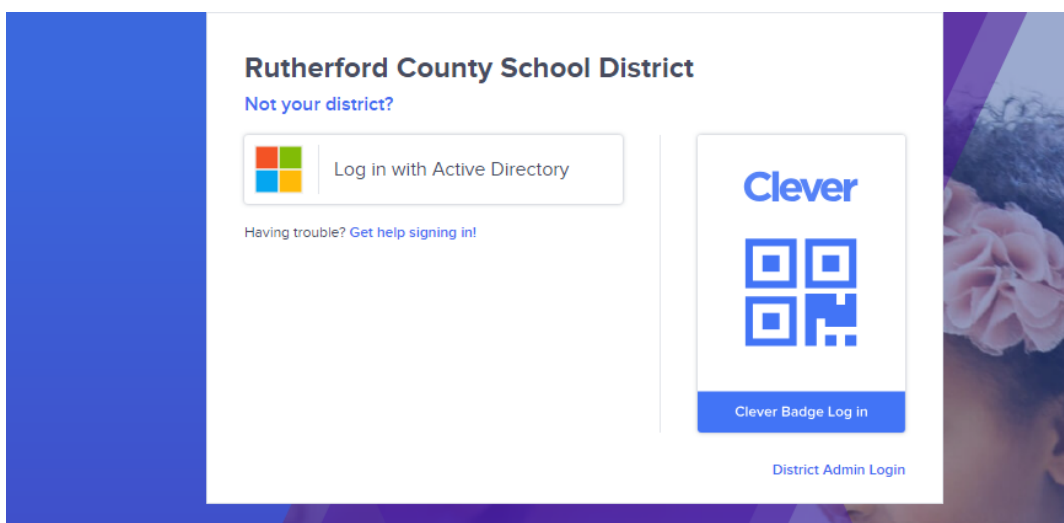

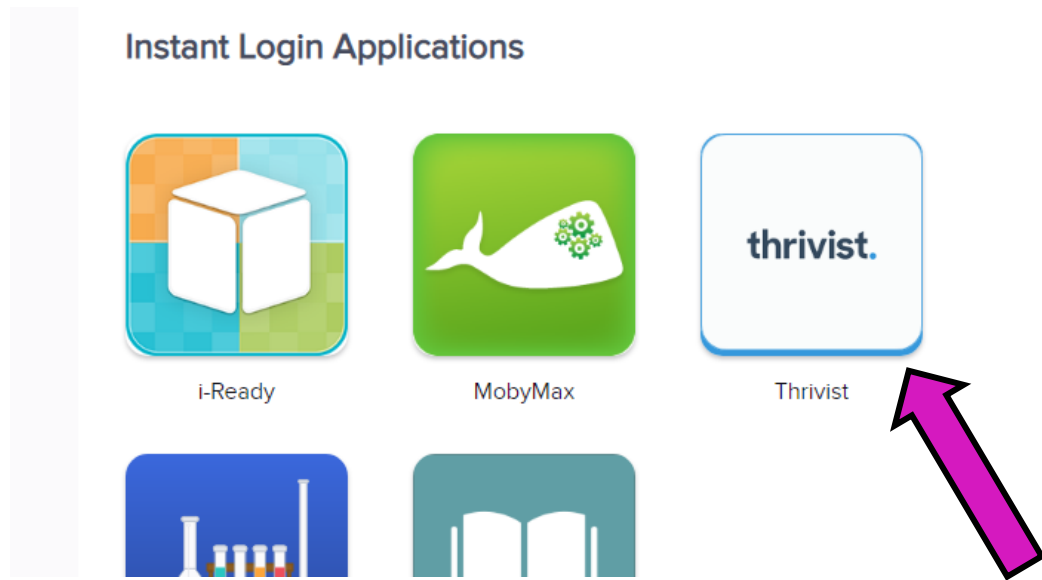
- 1) At the Rockvale Middle webpage, select “CLEVER (IREADY?MOBYMAX)” under the Students drop down menu.



- 2) Student will log in using their regular username and password.



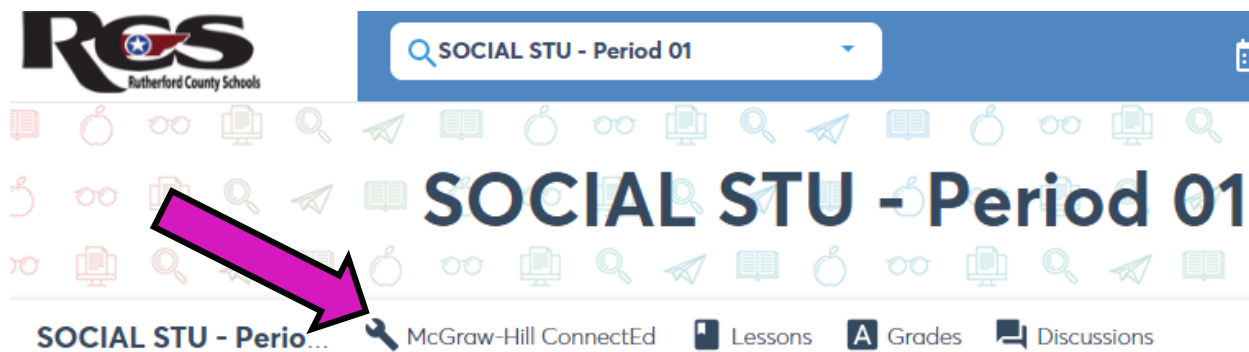
3) Student will click on “Thrivist”.

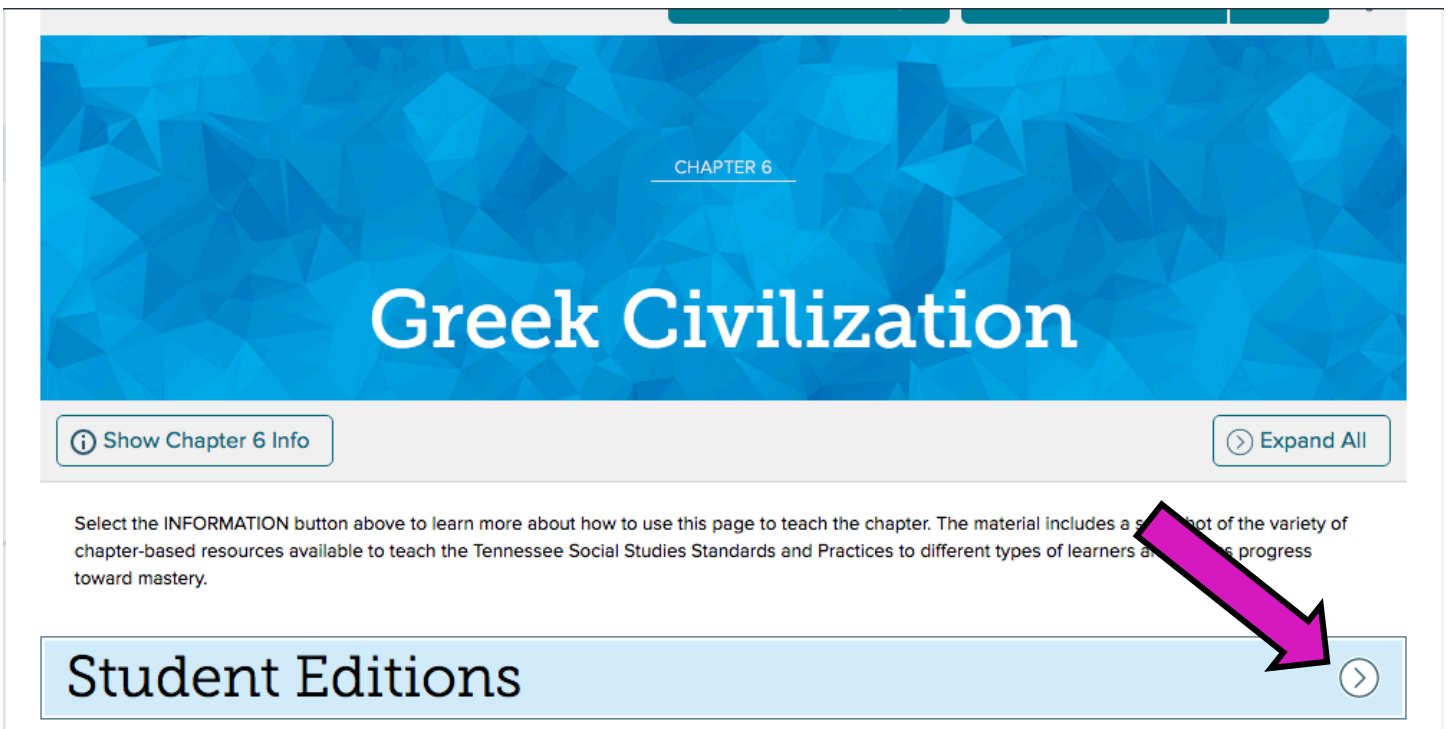
